

The parent community support, which was successful in lobbying to establish the school in 1913 has continued, with a pro-active Parents' and Citizens' Association and School Council. Parents are also involved in many facets of the children's education.

School policies and structures are in place to support students with specific needs. A Student Representative Council and Student Parliament ensures that the voices of the students are heard.

There are strong inter and intra school sports programmes, and teams excel at district level in softball, rugby, athletics and swimming.

A creative arts room and pottery kiln is used to their fullest extent. Excursions are a regular feature of school life, from Kindergarten through to Year 6.

Regular celebrations include Easter, Multicultural days, Anzac Day, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Week and Year 6 graduation with combined church services at Easter, Christmas and during Education week.
